5 Introduced by Erdman, 47

6 PURPOSE: The Legislature recognizes the importance of accessible  
7 air service and airport facilities for general aviation to the  
8 economic development throughout the State of Nebraska. The purpose  
9 of this study is to consider the steps that can be taken to support  
10 and develop general aviation and airport facilities in Nebraska.  
11 This study shall include, but not be limited to, gathering  
12 information on the level and type of use, governance, financing,  
13 and promotion of airport facilities. Input shall be solicited from  
14 the Nebraska Aeronautics Commission, the Department of Aeronautics,  
15 academic professionals familiar with aviation and economic  
16 development, supporting industry, airport users, and others with  
17 information about general aviation.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE  
19 NINETY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

20 1. That the Transportation and Telecommunications  
21 Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an  
22 interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

23 2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its  
24 study make a report of its findings, together with its  
25 recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
