7 Nebraska, and a student at Lakeview High School, has achieved
8 national recognition for exemplary volunteer service by receiving a
9 2004 Prudential Spirit of Community Award; and

10 WHEREAS, this prestigious award, presented by Prudential
11 Financial in partnership with the National Association of Secondary
12 School Principals, honors young volunteers across America who have
13 demonstrated an extraordinary commitment to serving their
14 communities; and

15 WHEREAS, Emily Wemhoff earned this award by giving
16 generously of her time and energy to design and complete a
17 community-wide fire safety awareness phone survey, use grant
18 funding to purchase and deliver free smoke alarms to every
19 unprotected residence as well as educating the public about house
20 fires, regular testing of smoke alarms, and developing a family
21 escape plan in case of fire; and

24 society depends, in great measure, upon the dedication of young
25 people like Emily Wemhoff who use their considerable talents and
