6 WHEREAS, Charles "Bud" Pentz was born in Joliet,
7 Illinois, on April 13, 1916, and died on February 29, 2004; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Pentz was a well-known and respected
9 broadcaster for more than 35 years and was the owner/operator of
10 the radio station KWBE from the early 1950s and started KMAZ in
11 1962; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Pentz was inducted into the Nebraska
13 Broadcasters Association Hall of Fame in 1977 and received the
14 Nebraska Broadcast Pioneer Award for extraordinary leadership in
15 the broadcasting business and support of broadcast education in
16 2002; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Pentz was an active member of various
18 community organizations in Beatrice and Nebraska until 1987.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
20 NINETY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

21 1. That the Legislature extends its sympathies to Mr.
22 Pentz's wife, Mrs. Dorothy Pentz, his daughter Jana Pentz-McBride,
23 and his family for their loss.
