6 WHEREAS, former Nebraska first lady Maxine Morrison, wife
7 of former Governor Frank Morrison, died March 18, 2004; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Morrison was born September 18, 1915, in
9 Greeley, Nebraska. She spent her life as a teacher, musician,
10 fashion director, real estate broker, and television and radio
11 host; and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Morrison served as first lady of the state
13 from 1961 to 1967; and

14 WHEREAS, Mrs. Morrison was a person who demonstrated
15 inspiration, commitment, and determination. In addition to serving
16 as first lady, she also was the Democratic nominee for Nebraska's
17 Second District congressional seat in 1968. Her other honors
18 include serving as chairwoman of the First Ladies of America and on
19 the national board of directors for Arbor Day.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
21 NINETY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:
