4 LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 390

5 Introduced by Baker, 44

6 PURPOSE: To review and research issues raised by members of the
7 Legislature, agencies, instrumentalities of government, and the
8 public during the Legislature's consideration of LB 1176 (2004),
9 and to identify solutions to assist the Statewide Communications
10 Alliance of Nebraska (SCAN) with the implementation and successful
11 operation of a statewide public safety interoperable data and voice
12 communication system in the most efficient, practical, timely, and
13 effective manner for the benefit of all the citizens of the state,
14 as well as to address the needs of the public and private users of
15 the system and those public and private organizations and
16 enterprises that will supply the required services, facilities,
17 equipment, and support to create and sustain such a statewide
18 system. The study shall:

19 (1) Review the statutory provisions of the Nebraska
20 Public Safety Wireless Communication System Act;

21 (2) Review and solicit input regarding statewide public
22 safety interoperable data and voice service functionality and
23 access requirements among such system's users and interested
24 parties;

25 (3) Consider current and planned data and voice systems
26 and communications infrastructure and relevant funding plans;

1 (4) Identify options regarding how these users and
2 interested parties plan to pay for the development and operation of
3 these current and future data and voice facilities, services, and
4 required operational equipment; and

5 (5) Discuss the cost of the development, operation,
6 maintenance, and necessary upgrades required to meet a level of
7 statewide service.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
9 NINETY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND SESSION:

10 1. That the Transportation and Telecommunications
11 Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an
12 interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

13 2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its
14 study make a report of its findings, together with its
15 recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
