6 WHEREAS, Nebraska men and women in the National Guard or
7 Reserves have been recently called to active duty by their
8 Commander-in-Chief; and

9 WHEREAS, our servicemen and servicewomen must leave
10 family and friends and travel to distant locations throughout the
11 United States as well as the world, and, in addition, those in the
12 National Guard and Reserves must put careers on hold; and

13 WHEREAS, by serving in the armed forces of the United
14 States our servicemen and servicewomen put their lives in harm's
15 way for the sake of their nation; and

16 WHEREAS, the ability of members of the armed forces to
17 perform their missions requires the support and sacrifice of their
18 families; and

19 WHEREAS, many employers find their employees in the
20 National Guard or Reserve called to active duty, and such employers
21 are called upon in the spirit of patriotism to maintain job
22 security for those mobilized personnel and their families.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
24 NINETY-EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

25 1. That the Nebraska Legislature commends the sacrifice
26 and commitment of all Nebraskans in the armed forces of the United

1 States, whether on active duty, in the National Guard, or in the
2 Reserves.

3 2. That the Nebraska Legislature commends the families
4 of Nebraska servicemen and servicewomen for supporting their loved
5 ones while bearing the burden of separation from them.

6 3. That the Nebraska Legislature commends Nebraska
7 employers that support their employees in the National Guard and
8 Reserves and maintain their job security while they are mobilized.
