**Introducer's Statement of Intent**  
**LB 1045**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1045 creates a new food establishment category under the Nebraska Pure Food Act. The newly created category would be called a "Single Event Food Vendor."

If enacted, this bill would allow a food vendor who participates in only one event during a calendar year, and such event lasts no more than two days, to have the permit fee of \$57.50 waived and the inspection fee reduced to \$20. This bill in no way exempts them from current food safety requirements.

Currently, the Nebraska Pure Food Act includes such food vendors under the category of a Temporary Food Establishment. Under this category, they are required to pay a onetime permit fee of \$57.50 and a yearly inspection fee of \$57.50.

It is the intention of LB 1045 to lessen the monetary burden on such vendors, so as not to discourage the participation in long running community and cultural events.
