LB 194

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 194 would amend the statute creating the Nebraska Workforce Investment Board (§48-1623) by adding new language that would make mayors of metropolitan or primary class cities required members of the Board, rather than optional appointees. The bill would further allow the governor and such mayors to appoint a representative to attend meetings in their place. Selected representatives would be nonvoting, and would not be considered board members when determining whether there is a quorum.
