The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 221 removes the existing requirement for a pharmacist licensed in another state to have practiced pharmacy for at least one year in the state of original licensure in order to have the state of Nebraska recognize his or her out-of-state license for purposes of practicing in Nebraska.

LB 221 updates and modernizes the “drug product selection” or “generic substitution” provisions of Nebraska law.
