The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Current Nebraska law prohibits a probationer, inmate or parolee from acting as an undercover agent for law enforcement. No other state has such a restriction.

LB 361 assists Nebraska law enforcement by allowing a probationer, inmate or parolee with their consent to act as an undercover agent. Only inmates of state correctional facilities would still be prohibited.

The parole board or a judge with jurisdiction of the probationer, inmate or parolee must approve.
