The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The intent of LB 86 is to provide an option to municipalities when it comes to the regulation of local traffic matters.

Current state law prohibits the use of roadways for volunteer fundraising activity. LB 86 allows municipalities, through the adoption of a city ordinance, to allow pedestrians to solicit contributions on roadways within their corporate boundaries if the contributions are to be devoted to charitable or community betterment purposes.
