**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of Legislative Bill is to provide for the design and sale of child abuse prevention license plates. The design chosen shall reflect support for preventing child abuse in Nebraska and a portion of the revenue generated by the sale of the plates will be directed to the Nebraska Child Abuse Prevention Fund.

The Nebraska Child Abuse Prevention Fund is administered by the Nebraska Child Abuse Prevention Fund Board, which is given several duties under state law to assist with the prevention of child abuse in Nebraska. As a result of this legislation, the Board would be directed to review the recommendations of the 2003 Governor's Children's Task Force report and to utilize the revenue to implement selected recommendations or other child abuse and neglect prevention programs.
