The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The purpose of Legislative Bill 943 is to eliminate the statute of limitations for certain sexual offenses against children. These offenses include:

- § 28-320.01 - Sexual Assault of a Child;
- § 28-319 – Sexual Assault in the First Degree (when the victim is under 16 years of age at the time of the offense); and
- § 28-320 - – Sexual Assault in the Second or Third Degrees (when the victim is under 16 years of age at the time of the offense).
