## LEGISLATIVE BILL 103

## Approved by the Governor February 3, 2003

Introduced by Baker, 44

AN ACT relating to rules of the road; to amend section 60-6,294.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change the speed limit for agricultural floater-spreader implements; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- Section 1. Section 60-6,294.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 60-6,294.01. (1) The Legislature finds that highway and roadway travel by agricultural floater-spreader implements is incidental to their designed purpose and use and that their use is essential to the agricultural industry of the State of Nebraska.
- (2) Agricultural floater-spreader implement means self-propelled equipment which is designed and used exclusively to carry and apply fertilizer, chemicals, or related products to agricultural soil and crops and which has a gross laden weight of forty-eight thousand pounds or less and is equipped with floatation tires.
- (3) Subsections (2) and (3) of section 60-6,294 shall not apply to agricultural floater-spreader implements. This exemption does not include travel upon the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways.
- (4) When operated upon any highway, an agricultural floater-spreader implement shall not be operated at a speed in excess of  $\frac{1}{2}$  forty miles per hour.
- Sec. 2. Original section 60-6,294.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
