AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 60-1308, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to state weighing stations and portable scales; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-1308, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

60-1308. The driver of any motor truck, truck-tractor, semitrailer, trailer, or towed vehicle who shall fail fails to step at obey any sign, message board, or in-cab signal from any state weighing station or portable scale or who shall knowingly pass or bypass passes or bypasses any state weighing station or portable scale, when the same station or scale is open and being operated by peace officers, or the driver of any bus who shall fail to step at or who shall knowingly pass or bypass any state weighing station except permanently established weighing stations authorized under section 60-1301, when the same is open and being operated by peace officers, shall be deemed an officer of the Nebraska State Patrol, is guilty of a Class III misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. Original section 60-1308, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
