AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 60-529, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2002; to change provisions relating to proof of financial responsibility; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 60-529, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2002, is amended to read:

filing with the department the written certificate of any insurance carrier, duly authorized to do business in this state, or (2) electronic transmission of a certificate by an insurance carrier, duly authorized to do business in this state, certifying that there is in effect a motor vehicle liability policy for the benefit of the person required to furnish proof of financial responsibility, also known as an SR-22 certificate. Such certificate shall give the effective date of such motor vehicle liability policy, which date shall be the same as the effective date of the certificate, and designate, by explicit description or by appropriate reference, all motor vehicles covered thereby, unless the policy is issued to a person who is not the owner of a motor vehicle. A certificate of insurance for fleet vehicles may include, as an appropriate reference, a designation that the insurance coverage is applicable to all vehicles owned by the named insured, or wording of similar effect, in lieu of an explicit description.

Sec. 2. Original section 60-529, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2002, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
