SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: In addition, Mr. President, a number of new bills. (Read LB 122-190 by title for the first time.) And that's all I have at this time, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 57-69.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will stand at ease for further bill introduction. Senators, if you have any bills, why, please bring them up and we'll get them recorded. Thank you.
