SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. All in favor. Any objection? Seeing no objection, it is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, for clarification, tell us where we are.

CLERK: I have nothing further pending to the motion to adopt permanent rules, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We're back on permanent rules. Senator Hudkins.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Mr. President and members. We have adopted the various parts of the proposal with the appropriate insertions and deletions and some changes. I don't think that I need to go through and explain what those are unless someone has a specific question. I appreciate all of the debate. We have taken one day to do this and I think that might be a record, I'm not sure, but it would be nice then to be able to finish today with the adoption of the permanent rules so we can start first thing tomorrow morning operating under those rules. And so, unless you have specific questions, that will be my closing. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There are no lights on, so that...it was your closing, Senator Hudkins. The question before us is adoption of the permanent rules, as amended. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Been a roll call vote requested. Mr. Clerk, call the roll, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 111-112.) 38 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of permanent rules.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The permanent rules are adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item.
