SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the tenth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain this morning is Reverend Daryl Lauber of the Bethany Christian Church, from Senator Marian Price's district. Reverend Lauber. Would you please rise, everyone.
