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FLOOR DEBATE

January 22, 2003 LB 4, 5

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, members, again, LB 4 simply expands a section to pick up a section that applies in the same area of law. Section 52-1322 was enacted by LB 1321 in 1988 and was codified in Section 52-1328. It cites that statutes to Section 52-1301 to 52-1321 should be expanded to pick up the Section 52-1322. That's all it does, so with that I close.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Are there any persons wishing to address or speak to LB 4? Seeing none, Senator Cudaback waives closing. Members, the question is whether LB 4 shall advance from General File to Select File. Again, those wishing that it advance please vote aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 4.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 4 does advance. LB 5, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 5 is a bill offered by Senator Engel, as Chair of the board. (Read title.) Introduced on January 9 of this year, referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you. Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker, members, as the Clerk stated, it simply cleans up internal references used inconsistently. In 2002, LB 446 amended Section 3-239 and placed definitions in the section itself. Before that, the definitions for Section 3-29 (sic) were found in Section 3-501, so it just cleans that up.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Any persons wishing to speak to LB 5? Seeing none, Senator Cudaback waives closing. Again, members, the question is, shall LB 5 advance from General File to Select File? Those in favor please vote aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 5.
