January 22, 2003 LB 11, 12

**SPEAKER BROMM:** Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Cudaback.

**SENATOR CUDABACK:** Mr. Speaker, members, again, as the Clerk as stated, I won't be repetitive here, but it simply takes a date out that no longer needs to be there, July 1, 2000. That date is gone. Just takes that out of the statutes.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Members, you've heard the opening. Any questions or persons wishing to address LB 11? Seeing none, we'll proceed to vote on the advancement of LB 11 from General to Select File. Those in favor signify by voting aye, and those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 11.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** LB 11 does advance. Next bill, Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** Mr. President, LB 12, offered by Senator Engel, as Chair of the Executive Board. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 9, referred directly to General File.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** Senator Cudaback, to open on LB 12.

**SENATOR CUDABACK:** Again, this bill simply repeals five sections relating to the Education and Career Preparation Task Force, which expired in December 31, 2000. The date has passed. These sections are no longer needed.

**SPEAKER BROMM:** Thank you, Senator Cudaback. You've heard the opening. Any members wishing to address LB 12? Seeing none, Senator Cudaback, do you waive closing?

**SENATOR CUDABACK:** (Microphone malfunction)...divided attention on this here. I know it's kind of an agony type thing, but needs to be done. Was established back in 1980 and this simply clears things up. You didn't know that you've just done away with your wage increase, but that's beside the point. But, anyway, thanks for listening.
