SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain this morning is from the Zion-Peace Church, Pastor Flores. Pastor Flores.

PASTOR FLORES: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Pastor Flores, from the Zion-Peace Lutheran Church. Thank you for being with us. Call the eleventh day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please check in.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: A Reference report referring LB 534-630, as well as LR 20CA, Mr. President. And that's the only item that I have. (Also referring LB 228 and LR 21CA, Legislative Journal pages 279-281.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We now go to General File. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill for General File discussion this morning by the Legislature, LB 68, offered by Senator Raikes. (Read title.) Introduced on January 9 of this year, referred to the Education Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill at this time, Mr. President.
