January 23, 2003 LB 58, 67, 86, 115, 137, 636, 660, 754, 755

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. You've heard the closing. The question before the body is advancement of LB 67 to E & R Initial. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on advancement of LB 67 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? We're voting on advancement of LB 67. Have you all voted? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 67.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 67 does advance. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. Senator Chambers has an amendment to LB 86 to be printed. And I have a series of adds: Senator Jones to add his name to LB 754, Senator Byars LB 660, Senator Synowiecki LB 58, Senator Aguilar to LB 137, Senators Landis, Schimek, Wehrbein, Chambers to LB 755, Senator Dwite Pedersen and Combs to LB 115, Senator Vrtiska LB 636. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 291-292.) Mr. President, a reminder, Reference Committee will meet upon adjournment in Room 2102; Reference in 2102 upon adjournment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Speaker Bromm, you're recognized.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. Members, I distributed just in the last few minutes a memo to you on designating your priority bills and committees designating theirs. If there are questions on that, please get back to my office. But next Tuesday, January 28th, would be the first day of priority bill designation and, of course, you have until Friday, March 14th. So, hopefully, it's self-explanatory, but if not, please ask questions. So with that, I would move that we adjourn until tomorrow, January 24th, at 9:00 a.m.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adjourn until January 24th. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed nay. We are adjourned.
