SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and will vote to give an operation carte blanche, virtually, to raise fees when that outfit says it does not need to raise those fees? Talk about hypocrisy. Talk about disingenuousness. And I'm saying it on the floor, so that anybody who disagrees can take issue with me. Here, you don't have to run someplace and mutter in your little gatherings about how upset you are with Senator Chambers and what the public will think about him running the Legislature. Speak on the floor or hold your peace. Don't be a coward up here and then brave someplace else. We're talking about the public's business. And there was a senator who said in the newspaper that at the end of the day, the people want the people's business done. And that senator is going to support giving a bureaucracy the power to raise fees,...

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...when it says it doesn't need the fee increase. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have a motion. I do have some items, if I may.

SPEAKER BROMM: You may.

CLERK: Thank you. Your Committee on General Affairs reports LB 126 to General File, LB 243 to General File, and LB 429 to General File; and Transportation Committee reports LB 238 to General File, those signed by their respective committee Chairs. Hearing notices, Mr. President, from the Natural Resources Committee. An amendment to be printed by Senator Schrock to LB 30. And Senator Dwite Pedersen has selected LB 46 as his priority bill for the session, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 321-322.)
