SPEAKER BROMM: One minute, Senator Vrtiska.

It seems rather strange to me that we would all of a sudden say, you can't do that, even if the Appropriations Committee and the fair should come and say, could you give us some, as you've been doing in the past. So obviously, I oppose the amendment, and would hope that the rest of you wouldn't vote it down, and we'd move ahead with this bill. Thank you.
