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FLOOR DEBATE

February 4, 2003 LB 49, 50

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Any discussion on LB 49? Seeing none, Senator Brashear, do you wish to close? He waives closing. All in favor please vote aye; opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 49.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 49 is advanced. LB 50, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 50, by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 9, referred to the Judiciary Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brashear to open on LB 50.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. The Revisor of Statutes has also identified a needed technical change relating to the number structure of the statute that sets for the procedure when an audio-visual court appearance is made. The change is not significant enough to warrant a separate Revisor bill. LB 50 strikes the erroneously placed "(3)"...number three, numeral three. It is proper and correct to have the paragraph appear under the subsection numbered "(2)" instead of creating a new subsection. The structure of the statute is made clear by the proper numbering of the subsections. The bill was advanced unanimously by those members of your Judiciary Committee present, and I urge its advancement. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Any persons wishing to discuss LB 50? I see none. Senator Brashear waives closing. All in favor of advancing LB 50 please vote aye, and opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 50.
