And I hope we can come to a vote on this, because Senator Cudaback has always worked with the electricians. He understands it probably as well as anybody in here. I'm no...maybe Jim is an electrician. He could be. I'm not too sure. And I know Senator Cudaback has done a lot of things throughout his life. Maybe that's one of his expertise also. Thank you, Madam Chairman.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Cudaback, there are no further lights, would you wish to close on your bill?
