SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on advancement of LB 355. All in favor of the motion to advance vote aye, and opposed nay. We are voting on the advancement of LB 355 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Voting on the advancement of LB 355. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 355.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 355 does advance. Mr. Clerk, any reports, announcements, or messages?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Thank you. Your Committee on Banking, Commerce and Insurance reports LB 464 and LB 494 to General File. Judiciary Committee reports LB 148 to General File; LB 344, LB 427 to General File; LB 136 to General File with amendments; LB 171, LB 270, LB 704, all to General File with amendments. New resolution, LR 30, offered by Senator Combs. That will be laid over. Hearing notices from Revenue Committee. Senator Quandahl, an amendment to LB 214 to be printed, and a new A bill. Senator Price offers LB 233A. (Read LB 233A by title for the first time.) That's all that I had, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 478-480.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item, please.

CLERK: LB 102, Mr. President, by Senator Baker. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 9, referred to Transportation and Telecommunications Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Baker, you're recognized to open on advancement of LB 102 to E & R Initial.
