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and we are not licensing. We are merely titling all-terrain vehicles. So it clarifies the wording and makes it more understandable. It doesn't change the meaning and so I urge the body to support the amendment and it clarifies it. Thank you very much.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Burling. You've heard the opening on AM0373 offered by Senator Burling to LB 333. Open for discussion. Senator Quandahl.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the body. I rise in support of AM0373 and would urge the adoption of this particular amendment. I just wanted to also note to the body that Senator Burling's office has been working with the bankers association in an attempt to resolve some of the issues that the bankers had over the phase-in of the titling requirement for these vehicles. Alas, an agreed upon amendment wasn't available at this time. I just wanted make the body aware of that right now. However, I don't want to stand in the way of the advancement of Senator Burling's bill. So I would urge the adoption of AM0373 and the advancement of LB 333. Thanks.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Quandahl. Any further discussion on the Burling amendment? Seeing none, Senator Burling, did you wish to close? He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM0373 to LB 333. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of the Burling amendment to LB 333. The motion is to adopt the Burling amendment. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who wish to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Burling's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Burling amendment was adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
