bill would be those that are solely used to revise ordinance or code sections, et cetera. That is, you couldn't mix in other things into the bill. And, secondly, it requires that it apply to situations where the legislative mandate is both specific and mandatory. That is, it cannot be a situation where, for example, the Legislature may give you two alternatives and you choose one or the other. It has to be a situation where the Legislature says this is the case and you shall do it. So that's all the amendment does, is to tighten down a little bit more on the definition.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Mines, on the...

SENATOR MINES: Madam President, thank you, and Senator Beutler and I have talked about his amendment and, again, it merely tightens down some language and I would propose and encourage the adoption of AM0422.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator. Are there...is there further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Beutler waives closing on his amendment, and the question is the adoption of AM0422. All in favor vote aye; all opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The amendment is adopted and we are back to discussion of the bill. Is there further discussion? Senator Mines? Seeing none, Senator Mines waives closing. The question is the advancement of LB 365 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all opposed vote no...nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of LB 365.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: The bill does advance, rather shakily. (Laughter) The next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 94, by Senator Schrock, relates to wastewater. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 9 of this year, at
