CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 628.)  
24 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to advance was not successful. I  
do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, next item. Items for the record  
if you have any, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Your Committee on Enrollment  
and Review reports they've examined LB 524 and recommend that  
same be placed on Select File; LB 60, LB 61, LB 561, LB 562,  
LB 562A, LB 563, LB 127, LB 175, LB 161, LB 30A, LB 31A,  
LB 143A, and LB 164A, all of those on Select File, some of which  
have Enrollment and Review amendments attached.

Mr. President, a series of Standing Committee reports. Your  
Committee on Health and Human Services reports LB 467 to General  
File with amendments; LB 645, General File with amendments;  
LB 667, General File with amendments. Judiciary Committee  
reports LB 267 to General File with amendments, LB 329, General  
File with amendments; LB 176 indefinitely postponed. Your  
Committee on Natural Resources reports LB 254 to General File;  
LB 449 to General File; LB 74, General File with amendments; and  
LB 431 indefinitely postponed.

Mr. President, priority bill designations: Senator Baker, as  
Chair of Transportation, has selected LB 209 as one of the  
committee priority bills; Senator Chambers has selected LB 688  
as his personal priority bill. A hearing notice from General  
Affairs Committee. Senator Baker, an amendment to be printed to  
LB 562; Senator Brashear to LB 121. And that's all that I have,

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 689 is a bill by Senator Redfield.
