SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the thirty-second day of the Eighty-Eighth (sic) Legislature, First Session. Welcome to the George W. Norris Chamber. Our Chaplain for the day is Reverend Bob Call, United Methodist Church, from Oakland, Nebraska, Senator Connealy's district. Please rise.

PASTOR CALL: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Members, please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Do you have any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs, chaired by Senator Schimek, reports LB 323 to General File, and LB 396 as indefinitely postponed. Priority bill designation: Senator Erdman has selected LB 526 as his personal priority bill. And I have an appointment from the Governor to the State Fire...as State Fire Marshal. That will be referred to the Reference Committee for a confirmation hearing, Mr. President. And, finally, LR 34, LR 35, LR 36, and LR 37 are ready for your signature; and a hearing notice from Government, Military and Veterans Affairs. That's all that I have, Mr. President.
