CLERK: LB 563. Senator, I have Enrollment and Review amendments pending. (AM7068, Legislative Journal page 630.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 563.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Mossey. The question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Baker would move to amend. Senator, I have AM0590 in front of me.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The Chair would recognize Senator Baker to open on AM0590.

SENATOR BAKER: I would ask that we withdraw AM0590 and substitute AM0694 in place of that.

CLERK: Actually, Senator, if we just withdraw it, yours is the next amendment, so. Mr. President, Senator Baker would move to amend with AM0694. (Legislative Journal pages 747-748.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The Chair would recognize Senator Baker, to open on his amendment.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Mr. President, members. Once again, a clean-up, sort of technical amendment. Because we're dealing with international registration plans and so on, they had to change the word "states" to "jurisdictions," since we're dealing with countries here instead of states, or states and countries I should say, and that's the gist of the amendment; simply a technical cleanup.
