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So that court orders and divorces done in foreign countries would be recognized here so long as the courts of that country and our State Department have established reciprocity rules or whether there are reciprocity rules between the state courts and that foreign country. Finally, the amendment incorporates certain technical updates concerning the use of electronic communications. The evolution of specific agency practices and forms and organizational changes are meant to clarify certain provisions. What's happened in the intervening decade is the rise of the electronic signature, the use of e-mail, the use of Fax to move information from one place to another, and sends those...they include, for example, the signatures on legal documents. What this does, essentially...to do is it says you can have an electronic transfer and the signature is still effective, rather than having to have a hard copy always making it's transfer from one state to another to effectuate the impact of UIFSA. I will tell you that there are a couple of potential amendments to this bill because they've been reported out from the Judiciary Committee. We would perhaps anticipate the offering of LB 629, which is the Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act, and there is an additional one with respect to protection orders. I would anticipate that on Select File perhaps Senator Friend might collaborate on an amendment to bring those bills into LB 148 and offer that to you on Select File. There is an amendment to LB 148. I will explain it when I'm called upon by the Chair to do so. I would ask for the advancement of LB 148. It serves sound public policy by making sure our state courts are used appropriately, that we not get into a battle of multiple child support orders coming from multiple states across multiple jurisdictions creating confusion in our recordkeeping and, ultimately, in the well being of children who have to rely on those child support payments for their well being and their staples of life. I would yield whatever time I have remaining to Senator Friend for whatever comments he might make. Although I've noticed that his light is on, and I await his remarks as well. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Friend, did you wish to speak with the opening?
