CLERK: To suspend Rule 3, Section 13, to permit cancellation of the public hearing on LB 805 by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. You've heard the motion. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. It does require 30 votes. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the rule suspension.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to suspend the rules was successful. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 688 and LB 357A to Select File. Enrollment and Review reports LB 94A as correctly engrossed. Your Committee on Transportation reports LB 208 to General File with amendments, LB 775 indefinitely postponed. LB 46 indefinitely postponed (sic-to General File with amendments), those signed by their respective Chairs. A new A bill, LB 165A by Senator Schrock. (Read by title for the first time.) Priority bill designations; Senator Stuhr LB 249, Senator Schrock LB 762, Senator Cudaback LB 743, Senator Brashear LB 255 as a committee priority, and LB 270, Senator Synowiecki LB 304.
