SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Good morning.      Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain of the day is Pastor Doug Deneui from Ravenna Congressional (sic) Church, Ravenna, Nebraska. Happens to be my district. I was going to say Senator Cudaback's district, my district. Thanks for being here, Pastor.

PASTOR DENEUI:      (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Thank you very much, Pastor, for being with us. We appreciate you being here. I call the forty-fourth day of the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, First Session, to order. Senators, please check in. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Are there any corrections for the Journal?

CLERK:      I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK:      Mr. President, your Committee on Education, chaired by Senator Raikes, reports LB 172 to General File, LB 574 to General File with amendments. Enrollment and Review reports LB 619 to Select File; LB 294, LB 607, LB 332, LB 165A, all to Select File, some having Enrollment and Review amendments attached. Priority bill designation: Senator Maxwell, LB 95; Senator Raikes, as Chair of Education, LB 685 as one of the committee priorities; and LB 335 by Senator Kremer; Senator Jensen, as Chair of Health and Human Services, LB 467 as one of the two committee priorities. The lobby report for this week, Mr. President, and finally a series of reports received in the Clerk's Office, available for member review. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President.
