43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 55 passes. LB 56.

CLERK: (Read LB 56 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 56 pass? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 865.)
45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 56 passes. LB 60.

CLERK: (Read LB 60 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 60 pass? All in favor vote aye, and opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 866.)
43 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 60 does pass. Members, the first vote on LB 61 will be a vote to determine whether we would suspend the at-large reading, pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
