March 28, 2003 LB 327, 451, 524

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thank you, Mr. President. I was informed in the meantime and I understand that these retirement funds and retirement systems of the school districts and the political subdivisions are currently being subject to an on-site audit, and so they are actually being audited right now. And so that's just some clarification that I was provided in the meantime. Thank you.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Quandahl. There are no other lights on. (Visitors introduced.) Senator Stuhr, to close on your amendment. She waives her closing. The question is the adoption of the specific amendment to LB 451. Vote aye if you support; vote no if you don't. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: It is adopted. Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 451E to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR LANDIS: You've heard the motion. Those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. And the motion is successful. The bill is readvanced. We move on to LB 524, the last of the Final Reading bills with motions to return.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bromm would move to return the bill for specific amendment AM0836. (Legislative Journal page 1049.)

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Bromm, you're recognized on your amendment...on your motion to return, rather.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. Members, what I'm proposing to do is to offer an amendment to attach LB 327 to this bill, which involves occupation tax collected by the Secretary of State. Those of you who have been around for awhile and to help new members understand the thrust of LB 327, some years ago, when we began the process of charging fees and setting fees for our electronic...access to electronic records,
