CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, you're recognized for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 165 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion before the body is to advance LB 165 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Could I have a machine vote, please?

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may. There has been a request for a machine vote. All in favor of advancement of LB 165 to E & R for engrossing vote aye, opposed nay. And a record vote. Motion before the body is advance LB 165 to E & R for engrossing. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
