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SENATOR BAKER: I have to admit it's confusing to me too, until I look at it. Now I do see what it does. Two effective dates on the...in the bill.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Section 6 through 21,...

SENATOR BAKER: Yes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...23 and 25 become operative.

SENATOR BAKER: Do not become operative...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Do become operative in 2005.

SENATOR BAKER: Right. That explains...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And the rest of them...okay.

SENATOR BAKER: The rest of the bill becomes operative, you know, when it's signed into law.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And that's not new language? It's not underlined.

SENATOR BAKER: It is the amendments. It's part of the amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. Thank you very much.

SENATOR BAKER: We'd be glad to visit with you, Legal Counsel here, if you'd like off the...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I just want to make sure it's...that I understand it and that it's done so there's not a hole in there somewhere,...

SENATOR BAKER: No hole.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...because I do think this education part is really a very important part of this bill.
