April 11, 2003 LB 186, 233, 233A, 250

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 186 passes. Mr. Clerk, LB 233.

CLERK: (Read LB 233 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 233 with the emergency clause attached pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1241.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 233 passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, LB 233A.

CLERK: (Read LB 233A on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 233A with the emergency clause attached pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1242.) 39 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 7 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 233A has passed. If I may, the cookies that are being passed around are in honor of Senator Burling's 49th wedding anniversary. Congratulations, Senator Burling. LB 250. The first vote will be to suspend the at-large reading pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8. All in favor of that rule vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on suspending the at-large reading. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.
