SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: (Microphone malfunction)...then I think Senator Chambers has a good idea, a cooling off period where members can examine the amendment. And if they want to make some changes that are agreeable to all parties, that's fine with me. The amendments are not mine. Senator Wehrbein's amendment is pretty innocuous. It's something that's needed to help with the budget. Senator Hudkins' bill, I have very little concern about noisy airboats, but I think your proposal is reasonable, and Game and Parks thinks it's reasonable, and the airboaters think it's reasonable. Senator Erdman, I think you have a good bill...it's good after the committee got done with it, let's put it that way. And I have asked Senator Chambers to do the bracket motion as of April 22. I do want to have this bill passed. We have some time. But I do want to bring a resolution to some of these issues that are in LB 305 besides what's being attempted to be amended on this morning. So I would support Senator Chambers. I think he's put a bracket up there to change it, the date, to April 22. That gives us 12 days to work on it and we can go from there.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I will withdraw the motion that is up there and offer the substitute.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to bracket LB 305 until April 22 of this year.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on that bracket motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Schrock gave the rationale for this and it is not my intent to belabor the bill or slow things down any more than necessary, so I have nothing further to offer other than I hope you will adopt this motion, which Senator Schrock supports, and in fact suggested it to me.
