So maybe on General File we can...or, Select File, we could take a look at that. With that, Mr. President, I return the rest of my time to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. You've heard the closing on the motion offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, committee amendment. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of the committee amendment offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Committee amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the bill itself, advancement of E & R Initial. Seeing no lights on, Senator Redfield. She waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is advancement of LB 349 to E & R Initial. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. Question before the body is to advance LB 349 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 349.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion to advance was successful. Mr. Clerk, next bill.

CLERK: LB 498, a bill by Senator Dwite Pedersen. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 17, referred to the Transportation Telecommunications Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments at this time, Mr. President.
