knowledge to commit such a violation. All members of your Judiciary Committee present at the Executive Session voted to adopt the committee amendment and to advance the bill. I urge your support of the amendment and your advancement of the bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Brown, on the committee amendments.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President, I absolutely support the inclusion of the word "knowingly." It was always my intent that this be something that we would follow through on only if it was clear that the companies were doing something intentional. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Brown. Any further discussion on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Brashear, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments, and he waives closing. The question then is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 118. All in favor signify by voting aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER BROMM: The committee amendments are adopted. We're back to the advancement of LB 118. Senator Brown, you're recognized to close on the advancement, and Senator Brown does waive closing. The question then is the advancement of LB 118 to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 118 does advance. Mr. Clerk, LB 444.
