CLERK: Senator Kruse voting yes. Senator Tyson voting no.
Senator Louden voting yes. Senator Don Pederson voting yes.
Senator Wehrbein voting yes. Senator McDonald voting yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of
Senator Redfield's amendment to Senator Chambers' amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers' amendment, as amended.

SPEAKER BROMM: I do raise the call. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Clerk, I'm sorry. I'm confused. Which
amendment is this?

CLERK: Senator Chambers' amendment, as amended by Senator
Redfield's amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. I don't need to speak. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close on
your amendment, as amended. Waives closing. The question then
before us would be the adoption of the Chambers amendment,
FA1313, which has been amended by the Redfield amendment. All
in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Voting on the
Chambers amendment, as amended by the Redfield amendment. Have
you all voted that care to vote? Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of
Senator Chambers' amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.
