SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR STUHR: ...transfer students...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR STUHR: ...are governed by NSAA. And...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Or, NSAA, yes.

SENATOR STUHR: ...currently.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR STUHR: And...but as I have said earlier, what we are dealing with is the option student enrollment program, and those statutes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. And I understand that. But I guess what I'm wanting to ask you, if Lincoln wants its students treated the same way as other students, then does it have two options, or does it have one option? And I hate to use the word "option," but...I mean, do they have the option of getting the statute changed, or do they have the option of getting the NSAA to change their rules? Or both?

SENATOR STUHR: Possibly both. We did not have a hearing on the issue of transfer...on the transfer issue between school...between schools within a district. The hearing and the bill was introduced to address the student option program, which is, as I say, in an entirely different issue, because it is dealt...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Right.

SENATOR STUHR: In statute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I understand. But if we wanted to, if we wanted to, we could put an amendment on this bill which would
