SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you have about a minute and a half.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. President. Thank you, Senator Janssen. I'd like to ask Senator Raikes a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, would you respond?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Raikes, the committee amendment deals primarily with this student fee...Secondary Student Fee Authorization Act. Is that correct?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. If all of this other stuff in the green copy on page 2 about eligibility were stricken, the bill would still carry the material relative to the fees and that would be all right with you. Is that true?

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR RAIKES: Let's see, actually, I want to make sure I understand. The committee amendment doesn't strike all the sections, so if I understood you correct, what you're asking me is that would I be agreeable with the notion of moving forward with the fees part of the proposal but not the option student, if that's a correct characterization?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Well, I will consider that. I do think the discussion has been informative and I'll try to make another point or two if given my time on the option student issue.
