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SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Kruse.

SENATOR KRUSE: Mr. President, I'd call the question.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do. The question before you is to cease debate. All those in favor signify by aye, those...nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Kruse.

SENATOR KRUSE: I guess we will have to have a call of the house.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The question before you is to have the house go under call. All those in favor signify by aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The house is under call. Will all those unexcused please return to the Chamber. Members, please check in. Senator Thompson, Senator Quandahl, Senator Mines, Senator Friend, the house is under call. Senator Kruse, will you accept call-in votes?

SENATOR KRUSE: We accept call-ins and you may proceed as far as I'm concerned.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Kruse has authorized call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Mossey voting yes. Senator Mines voting yes. 26 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Debate has ceased. Senator Stuhr, to close.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. What we are dealing with in this amendment has to do with the student fee issue, and what it does is add the one word "maximum" to the dollar amount of the fee.
