SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Stuhr, there are no further lights. You're recognized to close on AM1462 to AM0931, if you care to.

SENATOR STUHR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I'd like to again thank all of those that have been involved in this discussion. It is much more complicated than it appears on the surface. And what we are attempting to do in this amendment, then, in determining the eligibility for extracurricular activities, is that option students will be treated similarly as students who transfer into a school from another public, private, denominational or parochial school. And with that, I ask for your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. You've heard the closing on AM1462, which is an amendment to the committee amendments offered by the Education Committee to LB 249. All in favor of AM1462 vote aye, and opposed nay. The motion before the body is the adoption of the Stuhr amendment, AM1462, which is an amendment to the committee amendments to LB 249. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.
