and, in addition, we're going to build a new veterans' home? Well, or not build the whole thing, but share in the cost of a new...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Raikes, frankly, it's kind of a technicality. When I said the \$390, those are straight General Funds. Technically, this new construction here, and I probably erred in not making that perfectly clear, technically this new construction for the veterans' home will be coming from Cash Reserve Funds and will go right to the Capital Construction Fund.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: So it is new construction, but it's financed a different way, not General Funds. It's Cash Reserve.

SENATOR RAIKES: So it's sort of taken out of a savings account, if you will, rather than an income stream.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: And it will go into the Capital Construction Fund for eventually spending it, and I'll use my own time to explain why we had to do it that way, but...

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. Well, can you show me on the status sheet here? I see on line 18 the \$20,515,000 that corresponds with the numbers on page 71. I don't see on here a transfer for \$5,700,000 related to the veterans' home.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Cash Reserve Fund transfer? It's...well, it's on...it's on your tan sheet that was handed out. It's at the bottom, second line from the bottom, Cash Reserve...under Cash Reserve Fund: to NCCF,...

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...replace Fitzgerald Vets Home, LB 798 estimate. You see that? And it's also on...

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, so I see...I see there \$756,000, roughly, in each year of the budget biennium, and then...
